NEW FOR 2022

We will be offering two card options - one for Milwaukee County units and another for Racine/Kenosha County units.

- Camp Cards may be returned to the Council Service Center without penalty before the unit-settlement deadline of June 10, 2022
- The cards MUST be in new condition (including snap off discounts)
- No cards will be accepted for return after June 10, 2022
- You are responsible for 50% of the cards sold, to be paid at settlement

- The Camp Card Support Team reserves the right to refuse product that has been damaged or rendered unsalable
- UNITS are RESPONSIBLE for ANY unreturned cards (lost, misplaced, damaged, etc.)
- Be sure Scouts and parents treat each card as if it were a \$5.00 bill

CAMP CARD CAPTAIN

Each unit should have a Camp Card Captain. The Captain's sale responsibilities are to manage all aspects of the sale and communicate sale information to your leaders, parents and Scouts.

Camp Card Captain's Responsibilities

- · Communicate the purpose of the sale and timeline to your Scouts and parents
- Kick-off the sale with a BANG by providing all members with a sales kit & at least 20 cards
- · Inspect, coach, and praise your Scouts
- · Collect all money and turn in the amount due to the Council on time
- Promote reward program

How Will the Frontline Hero Sale Also Benefit Units?

 Between April 1st and June 1st, send friends, family & others to the Camp Card website and encourage them to select your district and unit.

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- We will deliver the camp cards you have sold as part of this campaign to Frontline Heroes by going to a hospital, grocery store, fire station, etc.
- The commission of \$2.50 per card sold through our website will be placed in your unit's account or a check will be mailed for earned commission.
- Scouts can also directly sell Frontline Hero camp cards. They simply collect the money for the card and notify the Council on their unit tracking sheet of the purchase upon settlement of their sale.

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HOW TO SELL CAMP CARDS

Your job as Camp Card Captain is to teach your Scouts how to sell. To get the best results, create a plan and train your Scouts to employ all sales methods:

- **1. Door to Door.** Take your sales kit and cards around your neighborhood & promote the coupons.
- **2. Show & Sell:** Set up a sales booth and sell CAMP CARDS on the spot. This can be an effective approach in the right location at the right time, but don't hang your hat on this approach alone. Focus on multiple locations at the same time. Be sure not to over schedule Scouts.
- 3. Sell at Work: A great way for Mom and Dad to help their Scout, take the Sales Kit to work!
- 4. Phone: Call your relatives, neighbors and family friends to see if they would want to purchase any cards.
- 5. Social Media: Use email or social media to let others know about the sale.
- **6. Double the Sale:** Let every customer know that they can purchase a second card that will be donated to local front line heroes.

SAFETY & COURTESY

- Never enter anyone's home
- Never sell after dark, unless with an adult
- Do not carry large amounts of cash
- Always walk on the sidewalk and driveway
- Be careful of dogs while selling
- Say thank you whether or not the prospect buys a Camp Card
- Do not talk to strangers alone

SALES TECHNIQUES FOR SCOUTS

Use the Camp Card sale to train your Scouts in public speaking, sales and service. Your Scouts and parents will appreciate the effort and sales will improve. Have Scouts role play and practice during your Kick-Off. Have your Scouts practice these simple steps:

- 1. Wear your uniform
- 2. Smile and tell them who you are (first name only)
- **3. Tell them where you are from** *(unit _____ within Boy Scouts of America)*
- 4. Tell them what you are doing (earning money towards Scout Camp, high adventure or camping gear, etc.)
- 5. Tell them what they can do to help (save money with the Camp Card)
- 6. Close the sale and thank them

WE'RE SELLING CAMP, NOT JUST DISCOUNT CARDS

Ensure your families understand they are selling character, they are selling a better community, and they are selling the benefits of Scouting summer camp, not just selling discount cards. Emphasize that each card sold helps a Scout go to camp. The reason our sale will be successful is because people want to support Scouting.
