Leadership: A Choice, Not a Title By Tyler Gerds, Communications Adviser

In Scouting—and especially within the Order of the Arrow—we often speak of leadership. We hold elections, wear titles, and refer to youth and adult leaders by their positions. But true leadership, as lived in the spirit of cheerful service, goes far deeper than a patch or a name on a roster.

Leadership is a choice, and an action—not a position or job title. This belief echoes a fundamental truth: anyone, regardless of age, rank, or experience, can lead. Leadership is not granted by a sash or earned solely by tenure. It is something we each choose when we decide to serve others, take initiative, or stand up for what is right.

Philosophers like Aristotle would tell us that character is revealed through consistent action. A Scout who quietly takes responsibility, who sees a need and fills it, who leads by example—not for recognition but for the good of others—is already a leader in the truest sense. This kind of leadership is lived, not claimed. In many ways, it aligns perfectly with the OA's call to service. Our ceremonies remind us that true leadership is not about command, but about commitment—about seeking the welfare of others before oneself. It is the kind of leadership that doesn't wait for permission or applause, but simply steps forward when something needs to be done.

In a world that often mistakes titles for influence and authority for integrity, the Order of the Arrow calls us back to something deeper. To lead is to serve. To serve is to act. And to act is always a choice.

So whether or not you hold an official role in the lodge, remember: you have the power to lead—today, right now. The lodge, and the world, need more leaders who live that choice.
