The 2023 National Scout Jamboree is scheduled for July 19-28, 2023 at the Jamboree's permanent home, the Bechtel Family National Scout Reserve in West Virginia. We just call it "The Summit" for short! Almost 31,000 Scouts and Venturers from all over the world attend the 2017 Jamboree. Join us and explore almost 11,000 acres of Scouting high adventure. The 2023 Jamboree will be the most action-packed Scouting event ever – with mountain biking, paddle boarding, skateboarding, rock climbing, zip lines, whitewater rafting, kayaking, scuba, shooting sports, ATV's, rock concerts and much, much more! Who's Eligible to Go?

Scouts: You must be at least 12 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree. Young adults between 18-21 are able to attend this Jamboree.

Three Harbors Council's Jamboree contingent will include one Scout BSA Troop for boys and a partial Scouts BSA Troop for girls. A Troop consists of 40 youth and adult leaders. Four registered BSA members 21 or older.

What Does All This High Adventure Cost?

The fee for attending the National Jamboree with a Three Harbors Council contingent will be approximately \$2,050. That includes the Jamboree, itself, and motor coach transportation with meals en route. (Whitewater rafting is optional for an additional charge.) Payments for the 2023 Jamboree will be made to the Council on a specified schedule. A \$200 deposit is required at time of registration. Payments are only refundable if someone from the waiting list takes your place.

How Do I Get Started?

Signing up to attend the National Jamboree is a two-part process.
